CULTURAL ENRICHMENT

- A student will not receive a cultural enrichment slip no later than 5 minutes after a program begins.
- Each student must return his/her own cultural enrichment slip at the conclusion of each program.
- Cultural enrichment slips will not be accepted from students who leave the program early.
- Cultural enrichment slips will not be accepted once they have been collected at the conclusion of each program.
- Students who have scheduled classes during chapel services/programs on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 11:00 a.m. will receive credit if the instructor provides proof of your attendance in class for that day.
- All students must earn at least 72 cultural enrichment points in order to graduate.
- Each program attended qualifies as one point.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

- Students are reminded as a requirement for graduation you must complete 30 hours of community service.
- All community service activities must be approved by the Office of Student Affairs prior to starting such activities.
- Upon completion of your community service hours, the daily log and service learning contract must be submitted to the Office of Student Affairs located in the Wilkinson Building.
